SUMMER TERM 2018**

Thank you for your interest in private lessons at Slater Music Academy! We are confident we offer the finest music instruction available in the area, and we thank you for the opportunity to serve you. We offer private piano, voice, violin, viola, guitar (acoustic, electric, bass), banjo, mandolin, dulcimer and ukulele lessons. Piano Suzuki method is available for children as young as age 3 and *Music for Little Mozarts* is offered for children ages 4-6 in piano.

The Summer Term 2018 consists of one term of six forty-five minute lessons or nine half-hour lessons, taken anytime between May 28 and August 26. Tuition rates are \$198 - \$225 for the full summer term. Prices vary according to each instructor's qualifications. All instructors are highly qualified, but some have advanced degrees or special certifications that command a higher price. Students who wish to take longer lessons or more than six or nine lessons may do so; the cost is proportionately figured. Many of our families enjoy the flexibility of taking fewer but longer lessons during the summer. Students may enroll at any time during the summer and pay for the lessons remaining in the term. All summer lessons are pre-paid at enrollment; we do not offer trial packages or special payment plans during the summer.

and request reimbursement; others prefer to send you to a music store to purchase the materials yourself.

PAYMENT METHODS: Slater Music Academy accepts Visa, MasterCard and Discover, checks, money orders and cash.

WITHDRAWALS: Students may withdraw at the end of the term. Tuition refunds are only given in the event of an emergency. Materials and registration fees are non-refundable.

ATTENDANCE POLICY: **Please choose your lesson time very carefully, as only one excused makeup lesson during the summer term is allowed!** Lessons missed for non-emergencies (family vacation, soccer games, and other changes in schedule) will be made up only at the discretion of the instructor. Please notify the instructor at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled lesson time whenever possible if you must miss a lesson. Students arriving late for lessons will use only the remaining time left in the lesson. To cancel, please contact your instructor directly. **To cancel a lesson, please contact your instructor directly; do not phone the Academy.**

GENERAL POLICY: We encourage parents, siblings, grandparents and friends to sit in on lessons, if so desired. Children under the age of six must be accompanied by a responsible caretaker in the waiting area.
